

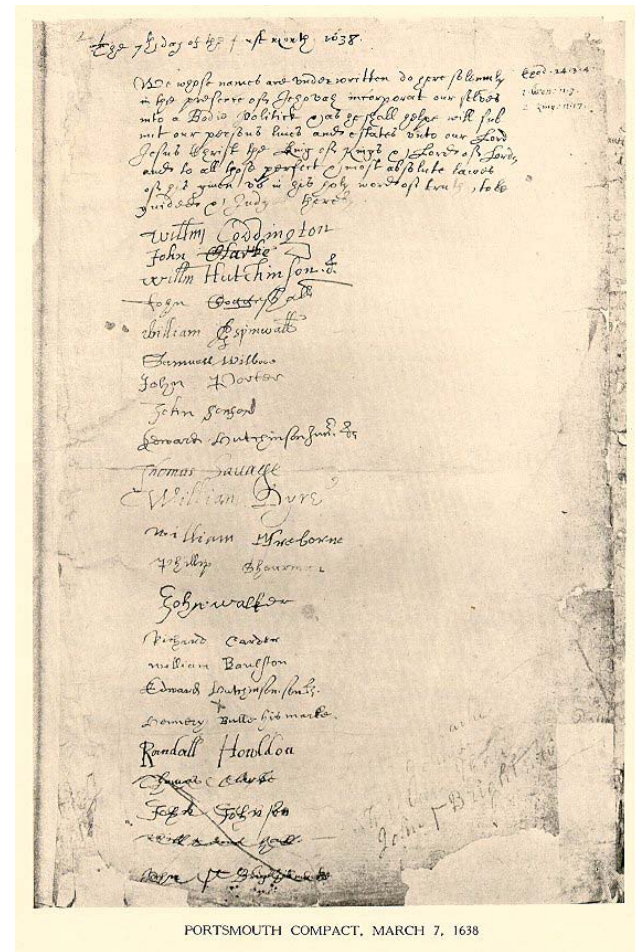

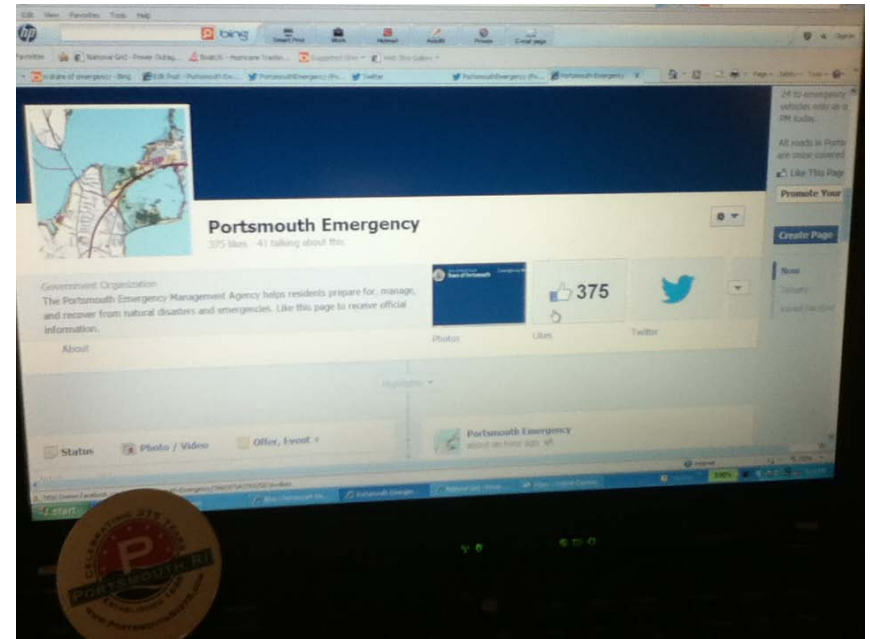

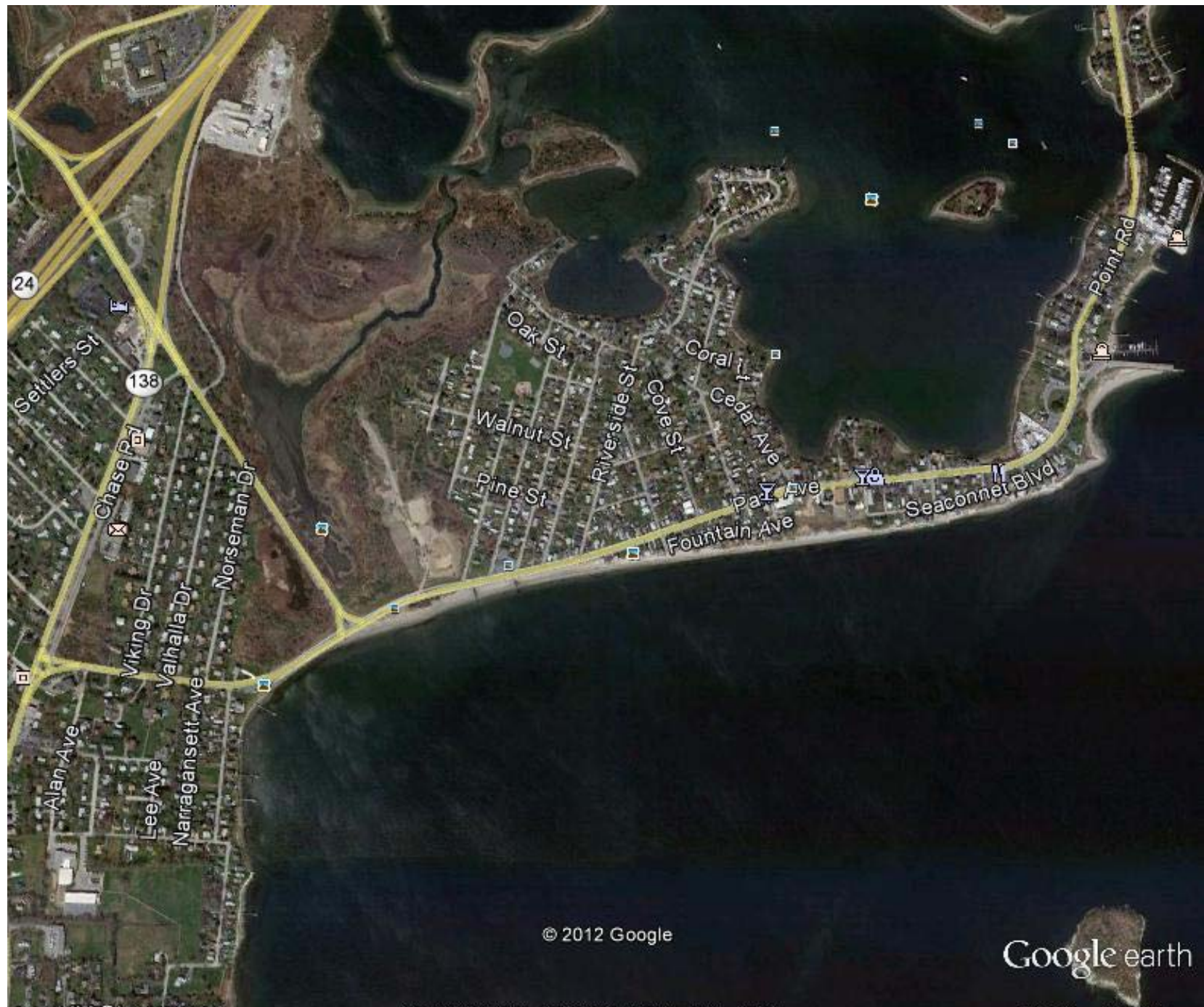


Events Committee

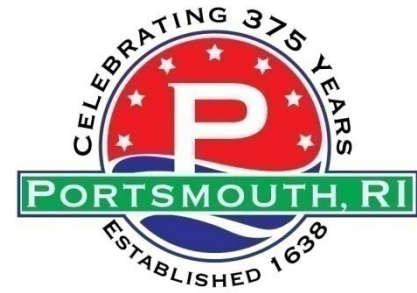
